Imperial Biscotti Break ***Evil Twin Brewing***

Pours thick oily black with minimal cappuccino head that lingers as a thin layer of foam. Coffee and espresso complement the slightly charred roast malt in the initial aroma. Chocolate and hints of fruity peppers add complexity. Chocolate and espresso dominate the flavor, with fruity pepper underlying. The finish is slightly bitter. Tobacco and dark cherry add complexity. Very rich malt profile. Sweet at first, but finishes dry . Notes of vanilla, caramel, and nutty, toasted malt surface as it warms. Body is full, smooth, and creamy with nearly no carbonation and significant alcohol warmth.
